

Dear parents and carers,

I would like to update you on the construction work taking place on Baslow Road. You will have seen that Amey are well underway with the building of a permanent crossing across Baslow Road, which will be in the same position as the temporary one is sited.


This work will continue during the half term holiday and should be completed by the time the children return to school on 5th November. On the school side, the lower Baslow entrance will gain a permanent metal walkway in place of the current, temporary wooden structure – this work should also be completed next week.

The upper Baslow entrance for pupils has remained closed so far but I have just been informed that some internal guard rails will be installed during the break to prevent any children from dashing straight out into the road (see diagram below). Please note that we will not open this entrance straight away as we will need to carry out a risk assessment on the completed work and decide how we will staff this part of school at each end of the school day to ensure effective safeguarding. Please bear with us - we will get this up and running as soon as possible.



On the next page, you will see the most up-to-date plan for the road markings due to be installed on Baslow Road next week. Please note that the Local Authority have agreed to fund the crossing warden for an additional 2 weeks into the new half term to ensure that children and parents are fully aware of how to use the permanent crossing safely.





Please note the major increase in parking restrictions on Baslow Road, which I have been told will be monitored and enforced by Sheffield Parking Services. I would also like to remind people that footway parking is an endorsable offence which could result in a police fine / points on driving licences.

Thank you for your support this half term as the building work has been finished off and our new school site has become fully operational. Best wishes for a restful half term break – I look forward to seeing you again on 5th November.
