Dear Parents and Carers

In keeping with Totley tradition, we have booked our trip to the Pantomime again this year. We will be seeing Peter Pan at the Lyceum Theatre in Sheffield on Thursday 13th December. Everyone in school will be going and for many years now, it has been a roaring success, with every child thoroughly enjoying themselves!!

Due to the fact that our school is growing, arrangements will be a little different this year.

FS2 and KS1

Following morning registration (normal time) all Foundation Stage and KS1 children and staff will be coached to the Lyceum for the morning performance which starts at 10.15 am. The show ends around 12.00 noon, after which children will return to school to arrive back between 12.30-1.00 pm. Afternoon school and The Nook will run as normal.

KS2

Children in the juniors will be expected to be in school as normal in the morning. After lunch, they will board the coaches and travel to the Lyceum for the afternoon performance which starts at 2.30 pm. We will return to school around 5.00 pm and all children will need collecting from school. If your child normally attends The Nook, staff will be there to collect them. **If your child walks home by themselves, please return the slip below to authorise this.**

Lunch arrangements

Because of this tight turn around at lunchtime, we ask that **every child on this day brings a packed lunch to eat in school. If you are entitled to free school meals and would like the kitchen staff to make your child a grab bag, please indicate by sending the slip back to school. FS2 and KS1 children are entitled to a free school grab bag as per the free school meals arrangements but this needs ordering too by returning the slip.** Please note, there will not be a meal for any child who has not pre-ordered a grab bag.

I would like to express my thanks to the PTA who have once again agreed to fund the coaches for this trip and subsidise the tickets so that the cost of this trip can stay at the sum of £10. I would like to personally express my thanks to the PTA for this extra donation to enable the trip to stay at the same cost as in previous years. This is a voluntary contribution, but as I am sure you will appreciate, if we do not get the money in then the trip will have to be cancelled. If there are any problems with the cost of this trip, please make an appointment to see me to discuss this. Please can all payments be received in full on ParentPay by Friday 30th November. You do not need to fill in a permission slip as the permission for the trip is given via ParentPay.

We are looking forward to a great trip together (Oh no we're not!! Oh yes we are!! – it is a classic!) to celebrate Christmas as a school. Roll on December!
