Dear Parents and Carers,

Next term, we will be continuing to focus on the Victorians as part of our wider curriculum. To learn about what school was like for children during the Victorian period, we will be visiting a Victorian Classroom for a day at Fairfield House in Barnsley City Centre. At the school, the children will experience life as a Victorian school child. We have used the provider before, and the children (and teachers!) have always had a fantastic time. For these opportunities, there is cost involved and therefore a voluntary contribution is requested. The total cost will be **£11.50** (including the Victorian Classroom and coach fee). This contribution is voluntary; however, if we do not receive enough funding then we will have to cancel the event.
