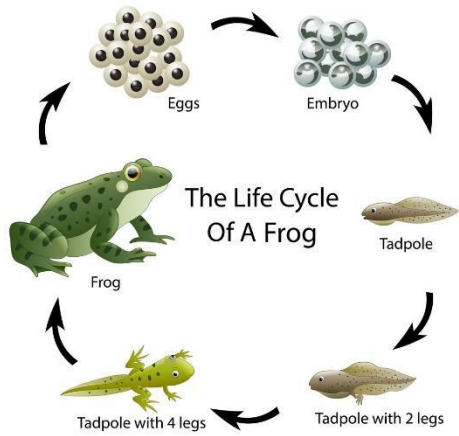
How do animals mature?

Frog eggs are laid in a group in the water by a frog. After 6-21 days, these eggs hatch into tadpoles.
 Tadpoles spend their time swimming in the water, eating and growing. It takes 6-9 weeks to grow into a tadpole.
 After 12 weeks, they grow legs (and then arms). It breathes underwater and still has a tail.
 After about 16 weeks, the frog is grown, breathes air and has no tail.

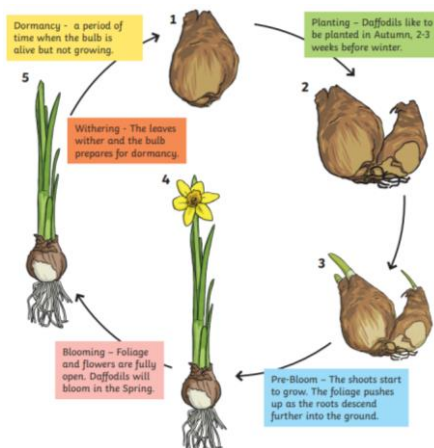



Planting- daffodils like to be planted in Autumn, 2-3 weeks before winter.
Pre-bloom- the shoots start to grow. The foliage pushed up as the roots push down further into the ground.
Blooming- Foliage and flowers are fully open. Daffodils will bloom in the spring.
Withering- The leaves wither and the bulb prepares to be dormant.
Dormant- a time when the bulb is alive but not growing.

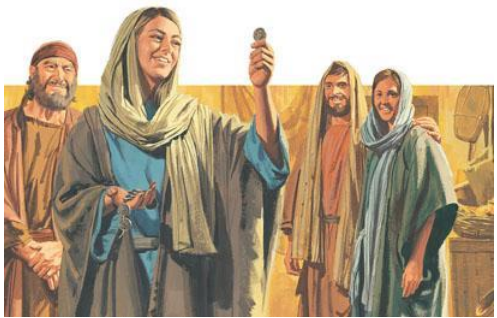
