- The bike must be in good condition as there is no time to do maintenance
- **Please REMOVE the stabilisers BEFORE bringing the bike to school.**
- All children to wear a **cycle helmet**, comfortable clothes and a smile!

Please indicate on Parent Pay if your child **CANNOT** cycle without stabilisers and would like to take part.
