Dear families,

This term, the school is offering extra clubs for Year 6 students. These sessions are optional and give children a chance to get used to an earlier school routine, helping them prepare for the move to secondary school. They'll also provide extra preparation for the Key Stage 2 SATs, which will take place in May.

We will be beginning two types of clubs for the Y6 children:

### **Club 1**

#### **Early bird sessions**

These involve the children coming into school daily at 8.20 am. From this time, the children will be able to do various activities including computer-based sessions on 'Education City' which will give the children an opportunity to work through a series of 'virtual lessons' and questions based upon their needs. These will be supervised by an adult who will be able to help the children when required. The sessions will begin on Monday 20th January at 8.20 am and run daily.

### **Club 2**

#### **After school tutoring**

These sessions will have a Maths focus. A high number of staff members have offered to run a tutoring club weekly after school for the Y6 children on either a Tuesday or a Thursday from the end of school until 4.15 pm. These will be group workshops focused on building on subject knowledge and discussing how to approach mathematical challenges. There will be six sessions, beginning on the week beginning Monday 24th February and will run on the following date:

We would highly recommend that your child attends the clubs available as they are free support for your child's learning, and will both offer support in the run up to the transition to secondary school and the KS2 SATs tests in May.
